Reimbursement Information

Reimbursement is calculated by paying for 50% of the cost of the registration for a first time participant. Lodging outside of what is included with a registration fee, mileage and extra meals outside of the registration are the participants' responsibility to fund. If/when a member repeats an experience a second time, reimbursement for the experience is at a rate of 50% of the first experience reimbursement. If/when a member repeats an experience a third time, reimbursement is at a rate of 50% of the second experience reimbursement. No registration reimbursement will be considered for repeating an experience greater than three times, except as noted on back.

Reimbursable registration for 1st time experience	50% of registration
Reimbursable registration for 2nd time experience	50% of 1 st time registration amount
Reimbursable registration for 3rd time experience	50% of 2 nd time registration amount
Reimbursable registration for greater than 3rd time	No reimbursement available – still encouraged to attend

It is each member's responsibility to accurately report repeating an experience. Failure to do so may exempt you from future funding by the Leaders Federation.

Financial Reimbursement Policy Guidelines (Revised March 2011)

Mission

The Polk County 4-H Leaders Federation has as one of its primary functions the financial assurance of the 4-H education program for Polk County. Funds are raised for this sole intent.

Requesting of funds

Fundraising participation is the responsibility of all leaders and members. Funds should be requested to enhance the educational experience of youth and not for the financial gain or abuse by anyone.

To receive payment within this policy, please submit the original receipt of registration or expense. Any deviation from this policy must be approved in advance of the educational experience by a personal request of the Polk County 4-H Leaders Federation Board at a regularly scheduled meeting. Leaders Federation meetings occur six times per year.

State/National trips covered

- 1) National Congress/Conference – Registration and travel expenses bill by the State to Polk County
- 2) Citizenship Washington Focus (CWF) – 2/3 of registration and travel expenses billed by the State to Polk County.
- 3) State Conference
 - A) First time attendee's expenses billed by the State to Polk County will be covered with the exception of \$25. Additional seminar expenses chosen by the participant choice are the participant's responsibility.
 - B) Youth who are attending as an Ambassador or have been selected for one of the State Teams will also pay the \$25 fee and any additional seminar fees. The remainder of the State Conference cost will be covered.

Assessments covered (Member dues are used to assist in offsetting these items as well)

- 1) 4-H Literature for members and leader; teleconferences and educational materials and media collection materials used for county educational workshops and programs.
- 2) Insurance for members through American Income Life and 4-H Foundation Member Assessment
- 3) Leaders Council meeting expenses for county representative(s).
- 4) District Talent Explosion assessment.
- 5) 4-H Camp Assessment plus 50% of camper registration costs.
- 6) Promotional materials for county wide 4-H promotion including National 4-H Week Window Display prizes. 1st - \$40, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20
- 7) District Talent Explosion – Ambassador and adult workers \$5.00 toward lunch.
- 8) Area Animal Science Days, Judging Teams/Bowls registration fees
- 9) State Youth Leader Council Selected member assessment \$100.00
- 10) Chaperones where needed will have appropriate expenses reimbursed.

No State Fair Expenses will be reimbursed.
