Crochet Cables

FINISHED SIZE

One size fits most adults

FINISHED MEASUREMENT

22 inches in circumference

MATERIALS

- Patons Classic Wool medium (worsted) weight wool yarn (3½ oz/223 yds/100g per skein):
1 skein #202 aran
- Sizes H/8/5mm and I/9/5.5mm crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker



GAUGE

Size I hook: 14 sts = 4 inches; 12 rows = 4 inches

PATTERN NOTES

Chain-2 at beginning of row counts as first half double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCH

Post stitch decrease (post st dec): Holding back last lp of each st on hook bpdcc as indicated in instructions, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

HAT

Ribbing

Row 1: With size H hook, ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (9 sc)

Row 2: Working in **back lps** (see *Stitch Guide*), ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Next rows: Rep row 2 until piece measures 19 inches from beg. **Do not fasten off or turn** at end of last row.



Body

Row 1 (RS): Working in ends of rows, **ch 2** (see *Pattern Notes*), evenly sp 77 hdc across, place marker at beg of this row for RS, turn. (78 hdc)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 2 hdc, ***fpdc** (see *Stitch Guide*) around next hdc, hdc in each of next 3 hdc, sk next 2 sts, fpdc

around each of next 2 sts, fpdc around first st just sk, fpdc around 2nd st just sk (*cable*)**; dc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, hdc in last st, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, *bpdc (see *Stitch Guide*) around each of next 4 fpdc, hdc in each of next 3 hdc**, bpdc around next fpdc, hdc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * around ending last rep at **, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 2 hdc, *fpdc around next bpdc, hdc in each of next 3 hdc, sk next 2 sts, fpdc around each of next 2 sts, fpdc around first sk st, fpdc around 2nd sk st**, hdc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, hdc in each st across, turn.

Next rows: [Rep rows 4 and 5 alternately] 5 times.

Top Shaping

Row 1: With size I hook, ch 2, hdc in each of next 2 hdc, *bpdc around each of next 4 fpdc**, hdc in next st, **hdc dec** (see *Stitch Guide*) in next 2 sts, bpdc around next st, hdc in next st, hdc dec in next 2 sts, rep from * around, ending last rep at **, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in next st, *fpdc around next st, hdc dec in next 2 hdc, sk next 2 sts, fpdc around next 2 sts, fpdc around first sk st, fpdc around 2nd sk st**, hdc dec in next 2 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in next st, *post st dec around each of next 4 fpdc**, work in established pattern across to next cable, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, [hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc dec in next 2 sts] across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, [hdc in next st, hdc dec in next 2 sts] across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 2, [hdc dec in next 2 sts] across. Leaving long end, fasten off.

Weave long end through top of sts on last row, pull to close, sew ends of rows tog across to Ribbing, reverse seam on Ribbing so that when you turn up Cuff, seam will be on inside. ■

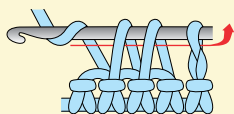

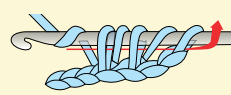
sl st (slip stitch)	=	sc (single crochet)
sc (single crochet)	=	dc (double crochet)
hdc (half double crochet)	=	htr (half treble crochet)
dc (double crochet)	=	tr (treble crochet)
tr (treble crochet)	=	dtr (double treble crochet)
dtr (double treble crochet)	=	ttr (triple treble crochet)
skip	=	miss

Single crochet decrease (sc dec):
(Insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



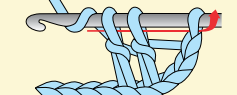
Example of 2-sc dec

Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec):
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



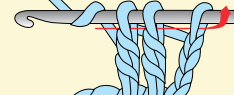
Example of 2-hdc dec

Double crochet decrease (dc dec): (Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



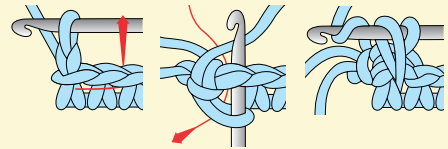
Example of 2-dc dec

Treble crochet decrease (tr dec): Holding back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

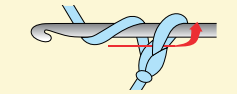


Example of 2-tr dec

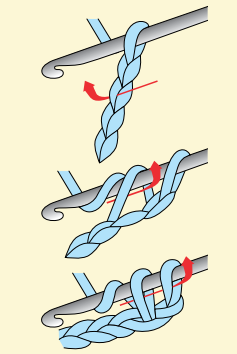
Reverse single crochet (reverse sc): Ch 1, sk first st, working from left to right, insert hook in next st from front to back, draw up lp on hook, yo and draw through both lps on hook.



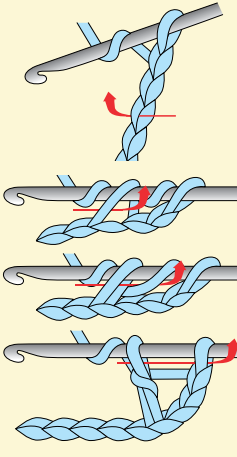
Chain (ch): Yo, pull through lp on hook.



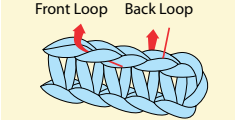
Single crochet (sc): Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.



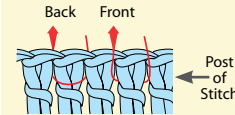
Double crochet (dc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice.



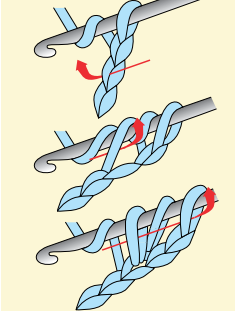
Front loop (front lp) Back loop (back lp)



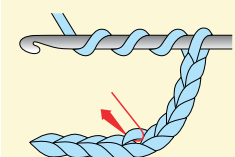
Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp): When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.



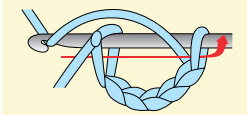
Half double crochet (hdc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



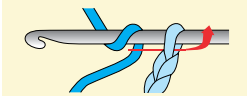
Double treble crochet (dtr): Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



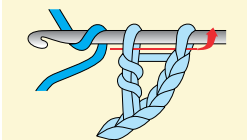
Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.



Chain color change (ch color change): Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.



Double crochet color change (dc color change): Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



Treble crochet (tr): Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
