



**Knit #121**

**EASY BABY HAT with either Rolled or Hemmed Brim**

**SKILL LEVEL**

BEGINNER

**LOOM**

30 peg round Boye Loom Knitter

**MATERIALS**

200 yards #5 chunky weight yarn or 2 strands lighter weight yarn

**DIRECTIONS**

Cast all pegs using e-wrap method.

E-wrap and knit 12 rows.

**For rolled brim hat:** Continue knitting until hat measures 7 inches.

**For Hemmed brim hat:** With only one set of loops on the pegs, lift the loops from the cast on row to the inside of hat and attach loops to corresponding pegs. Knit bottom loops over top loops to complete the hemmed brim. Cont to knit all rows until the hat measures 7 inches.

**Finishing**

With only one loop on each peg, cut working yarn leaving about a 24 inch tail. Thread the yarn onto a yarn needle. Starting with peg 1, insert the needle below the loop and pull the yarn through. Insert the needle into the loop on the next peg and then repeat around loom.

Insert the needle into the first loop again to make sure there is no gap. Remove loops from loom and turn hat inside out. Pull yarn tail to cinch. Secure yarn tail and weave in ends.

Turn the hat right side out. For rolled edge hat, lower edge will naturally roll to make an attractive brim. Add pom poms or tassel as desired.
