

## ***2025 Polk County Fair School Exhibits Division***

### **Class 35J**

Any student in grades 3-12 who is a resident of Polk County or who attends a school located in Polk County is eligible to exhibit school projects or work at the Polk County Fair in St. Croix Falls, July 23 – July 27, 2024.

Exhibits will be judged according to Danish system and every exhibit will be awarded a ribbon and a premium. Ribbon premiums: blue - \$1.75; red - \$1.50; white - \$1.25; and pink - \$1.00. Exhibits will be judged on separate grade levels, i.e. third graders compete with third graders, fourth graders with fourth graders, etc.

Exhibits are to be work or projects completed in school during the current school year for a grade or extra credit. Teacher must sign entry form below for current school year work verification.

**Exhibitors must bring exhibits to the fairgrounds in St. Croix Falls on Wednesday, July 22 between 1pm-7pm of the current exhibit year. Bring to Superintendent of Entries Office to get entry tags and exhibitor wristband. Exhibits are to remain on display until 4:30 p.m. on Sunday of the current exhibit year.**

The \$7.00 junior exhibitor season wristband admits exhibitors into the fairgrounds anytime from 7 a.m. Thursday to 4:30 p.m. Sunday of the current exhibit year. **PLEASE DISREGARD THE FAIR BOOK ON THE AMOUNT FOR THE WRISTBAND, IT IS \$7.00 FOR THE 2025 YEAR.**
