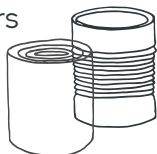


## Commodity Supplemental Food Program

Qualified seniors aged 60+ have access to free or donation-based food resources including:

- \* **Farmers Market Nutrition Program** to purchase produce at certified vendors from June to October.
- \* **Nutrition Program** offers hot, nutritious meals at nine locations throughout the county.
- \* **Meal delivery** if unable to visit dining sites, cook for themselves or have someone else prepare meals for them.
